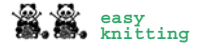


DOG COATS

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MEASUREMENTS

	S	M	L	
To Fit Chest:	45	50	55	cm
To Fit Neck:	35	37	40	cm

MATERIALS

Panda Magnum 8ply (100g balls)

Quantity 2 2 2 balls

or **Panda Woolbale 8ply** (50g balls)

Quantity 4 5 5 balls

or **Panda Woolblend 8ply** (50g balls)

Quantity 4 4 5 balls

One **pair** each 3.25, 4.00mm and one **set** of 3.25mm and a 3.25mm 60cm long circular knitting needle/s or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; knitter's needle for sewing seams; length of hat elastic.

TENSION

This garment has been designed at a tension of 28 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over rib, using 4.00mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt=alternate; **beg**=begin/ning; **cm**=centimetres;
cont=continue; **dec**=decrease, decreasing; **fol**=follows, following; **inc**=increase, increasing; **K**=knit; **0**=(zero) - no sts, rows or times; **P**=purl; **psso**= pass slipped stitch over; **st/s**=stitch/es; **stocking st** = 1 row knit, 1 row purl; **sl**=slip; **tog**=together.

BODY (beg at neck)

Using a **pair** of 3.25mm needles, cast on 101 (109-115) sts.

1st Row: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd Row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows until rib measures 11cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Change to a **pair** of 4.00mm needles.

Cont in rib, inc one st at each end of every row until there are 119 (131-145) sts, then in foll alt rows until there are 129 (143-157) sts.

Work 1 row rib.

Shape Leg Openings:

Next Row: Rib 13 (13-14), cast off next 10 (12-14) sts, rib 82 (92-100), cast off next 10 (12-14) sts, rib 14 (14-15) ... 109 (119-129) sts.

NOTE: Leg openings are worked at the same time, wind a small quantity of yarn into a ball for each section.

Next Row (wrong side): With first ball of yarn, rib across next 14 (14-15) sts, with second ball of yarn, rib across 82 (92-100) sts, with the third ball of yarn, rib to end.

Cont in rib until leg openings measure 5 (5-6) cm, working last row on wrong side.

Next Row: Working from first ball of yarn, rib 13 (13-14), **turn**, cast on 10 (12-14) sts, **turn**, rib 82 (92-100), **turn**, cast on 10 (12-14) sts, **turn**, rib 14 (14-15) ... 129 (143-157) sts.

Cont in rib across all sts until work measures 29 (31-34) cm from cast on edge, or until desired length to end of rib cage, working last row on wrong side. Tie a marker at each end of last row.

Beg Shaping Side Edges:

Keeping rib correct, cast off 16 (17-19) sts at beg of next 2 rows... 97 (109-119) sts.

Next Row: Sl 1, K1, psso, rib to last 2 sts, K2tog ... 95 (107-117) sts.

Work 1 row rib. Rep last 2 rows until 69 (75-85) sts rem.

Cont in rib until work measures 48 (50-51) cm from cast on edge or until desired length to base of tail. Leave sts on a stitch holder.

BACK BAND

Join seam from the neck edge to markers, reversing seam on neck section for 6cm. With right side facing, using a **circular** 3.25mm needle and beg at seam, knit up 42 (49-52) sts evenly along edge to sts left on stitch holder, rib across sts on stitch holder, dec one st in centre, knit up 42 (49-52) sts evenly along edge to seam ...

152 (172-188) sts.

1st Round: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st round until work measures 2.5cm from beg. Cast off **loosely**.

LEG BANDS

With right side facing, using a **set** of 3.25mm needles, knit up 36 (44-46) sts evenly around the leg opening.

Work 2.5cm of rib as given for Back Band.

Cast off **loosely** in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Thread elastic around neck edge, adjust to fit comfortably around the dog, fasten off.
